G2 Science Education Programme

The purpose of the science education programme is to give students the opportunity to develop and use their scientific knowledge.

For this to be successful, during the year we will need a number of parent volunteers to come to the school and help out with excursions and activities as the opportunities arise.

Every month or so, student excursions or activities requiring additional assistance will be decided, and a form similar to this one will be circulated asking for potential volunteers. The first science activity we are asking parents to be involved in this year is regarding **water pollution**. This activity will take place in the STEM Room on the school campus. The students will observe and strategize together to solve a (simulated) oil spill in the ocean. This hands-on activity will allow them to use different strategies to determine what is most effective at removing the oil from the water.
