2009!



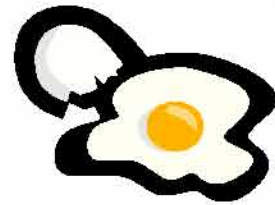
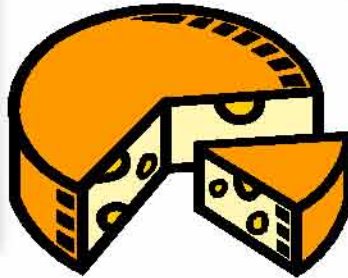
On 11th July, it was my summer vacation. So we packed our luggages and took a taxi to Hung Hom station. We went there smooth and fast.

We even drank a lot, oh! a lot, really a lot of jelly juice! It's sort of some jelly and some juice.

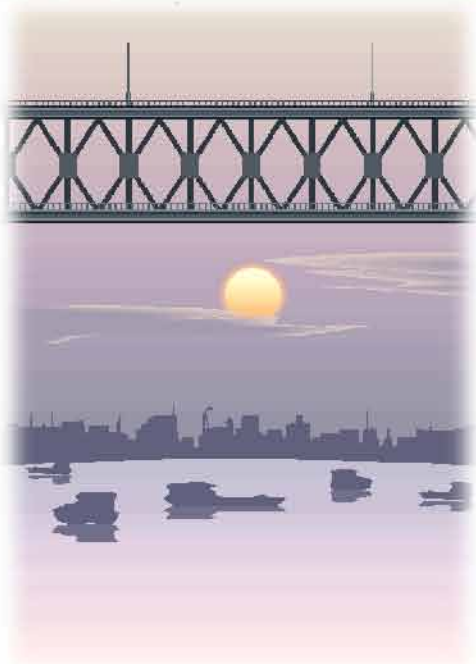
Soon, Chun Kin went to bed and I and MaMa went to explore the train until cabin no. 3. Then we all went back to Cabin 10, room 3 to sleep.

We went to the Bird Nest first. We walked around it. I found a little fun by stepping on metal holes. It makes a "Clang, clang" sound.

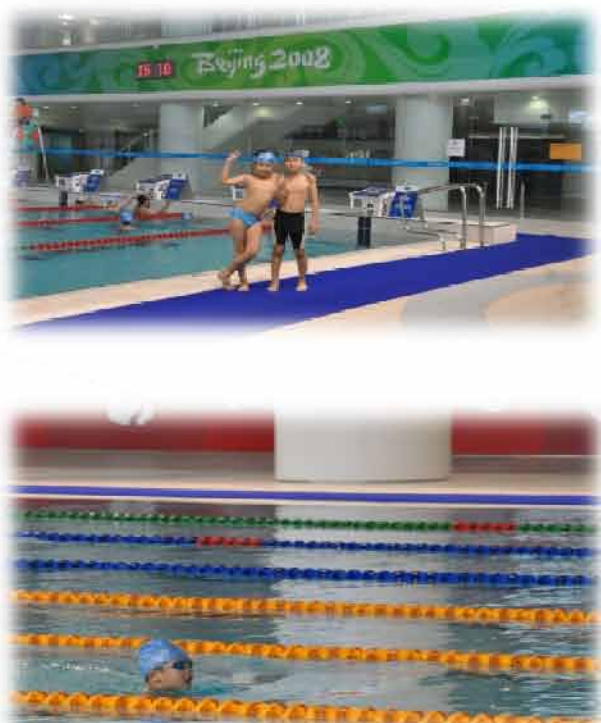
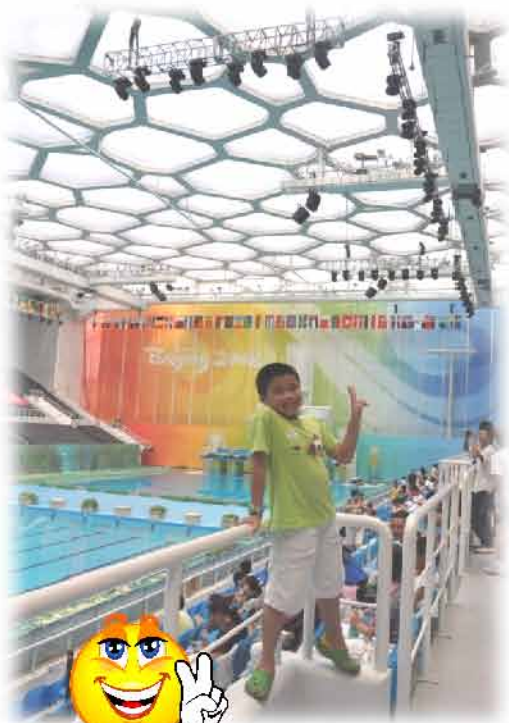
