The Staff Development Day 2021-2022 was held on 8 August. Teachers were divided into two groups for a 2-hour professional development talk. Ms Natalie Ho, Founder of Daylily Garden Family Education Centre, gave a talk on *The Best Way to Take Care of Students' Emotions and to Improve Learning Effectiveness* to local teachers. Ms Annie Ho, a Board member of the Feng Zikai Chinese Children's Picture Book Award, and an SSCPS parent, spoke on Pleasure Reading for Upper Primary Students to English teachers.

To establish rapport among our staff members, the Staff Welfare Committee launched a series of uplifting events for our school staff members over the year. To kick off the school year, a personalised thank-you card with a piece of fruit was prepared for each staff member. A series of team-building games were played to celebrate the Mid-Autumn Festival, and teachers won prizes in teams for their respective staff rooms to share. To celebrate Christmas, a gathering was organised where staff exchanged gifts and revealed their secret angels. It was hoped that these gatherings would give those who could not travel back home due to the pandemic the warm feeling of home at St Stephen's. At the end of the academic year, a surprise party was organised to celebrate Dr Wai's retirement.

#### STUDENT ENROLLMENT

In 2021-2022, a total of 721 students (382 boys and 339 girls) were enrolled. The number of girls and boys in each grade is presented in the table below:

#### TEACHING AND LEARNING

#### **ENGLISH**

The pandemic continued to disrupt the flow of teaching and learning from time to time this year. Lessons were conducted both face to face as well as virtually. Despite that, the English Department persisted in the face of adversity and did its best to normalise the situation for students. This year was about cruising through the existing curriculum in the best possible way. Teachers did their best to deliver the curriculum through interactive fun-filled activities to make learning engaging, and students eagerly worked through the concepts taught.

The English Department participated in various cross-cultural activities. Collaborating with the Visual Arts Department, G2 students designed a medicine bottle label for their reader, *George's Marvellous Medicine by Roald Dahl*. G4 researched the setting of their reader, *Butterfly Lion by Michael Morpurgo*, and then created 3-D models in groups to depict the setting of a chapter.

Students took an active part in a variety of interesting extracurricular activities. Students practised their language skills through speech training, chess club, drama club, debate club and the Hong Kong Battle of the Books, to name a few.

Our debate team participated in the  $3^{\rm rd}$  International Parliamentary Debate Competition (Winter 2022), where Tsoi Wai Ching (4C) was awarded the Top Speaker Award, placing  $14^{\rm th}$  in the Upper Primary Division. We also participated in the  $9^{\rm th}$  Primary Schools Debating Tournament 2022 and the UNESCO SDGs Debating Competition (2021/22).

In the Hong Kong Battle of the Books competition, our school competed against twenty-five Hong Kong schools. We came first in the semi-final heats and made it to the finals.

The 73rd Hong Kong Music and Speech Festival drew a lot of eager student participants. Students were trained by the English teachers, and they achieved some outstanding results. Four students stood first, nine students came second, and seven students were awarded third place.

In the Canadian English Writing Competition 2022 (Arch Cup), our school was named the champion in the Primary 1-2 division in the preliminary round. Additionally, in the Heat event of the 2022 (Arch Cup) Asian English Usage Contest, SSCPS was declared the champion.

#### **CHINESE**

#### G1-G6 Chinese Curriculum

In G1-2, where the emphasis has always been on language in daily life, new elements were introduced to increase student motivation. Conversational scenarios were added to G1 teaching materials to help students better express themselves in Chinese. G2 students kept a reflective journal on a pot of flowers that each of them was assigned to tend. This improved their observation and writing skills. In G3, a school-based writing practice book was compiled to consolidate vocabulary items learned in class and inculcate good writing habits, with a particular focus on journalistic and descriptive writing.

A guided tour to the Mei Ho House was organised to extend students' learning in the 'Hong Kong in the Bygone Days' module of G4 Social and Cultural Studies. Students learned about Hong Kong people's living conditions in the past. During the face-to-face class suspension period, G5 teachers made use of Padlet, an online platform, to arrange engaging and flexible group discussions and individual presentation activities. School-based teaching materials on reading strategies were also developed. Similarly, technology was given more prominence in G6. Students joined 360-degree virtual tours as part of the unit on descriptive texts. In lieu of traditional book reports, a booklet named Reading: The More, the Merrier with biographies, fables, fairy tales, texts by famous authors, the Four Classic Chinese Novels and newspaper cuttings were produced to broaden students' reading interests.

Activities play an instrumental role in facilitating the meaningful acquisition of the Chinese language and enhancing students' understanding of Chinese culture. An Inter-House Putonghua tongue twister competition was organised for G1 students to improve their pronunciation. In G2, students learned about the origins of written Chinese, idioms and traditional festivals via a series of fun games. G3 students participated in a Chinese poetry competition in which they experienced the joys of literary appreciation.

A talk by the Hong Kong Housing Society was organised to supplement their learning in Social and Cultural Studies. The author Alice Chan Yuen-shan was invited to lead an after-school online writing class for G4 students. Students developed valuable skills in planning a piece of writing.

第73屆學校朗誦節: Students participated in solo speaking in the Speech Festival. All Chinese teachers offered training to students. This year, 199 students participated in solo speaking (verse/prose) and obtained remarkable results. Nine came first, 12 came second, and 19 came third. All students achieved Merit (80-89 marks) or Proficiency (75-79 marks). Some other competitions and our results are summarised below:

第73屆學校朗誦節「宗教作品朗誦(基督教經文)」: One came first, and three came second. 2021年培生朗文校際普通話朗誦比賽: One came first, two came second, and two came third. 第28屆聖經朗誦節: Four came first, two came second, and four came third.

全港青年普通話朗誦比賽(公民教育)(2021-2022): One came first, and two came third. 全港青年中國古典詩詞朗誦比賽(2021-2022): Two came first.

# Alternative Chinese Programme 翱翔課程

Alternative Chinese Programme (鯏翔課程), designed to align with the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP), is aimed at developing students' analytical and critical thinking skills. The programme, co-led by the College and the Preparatory School, has been offered to G4-6 since September 2015. Students are expected to design their own research questions and engage in extensive reading of relevant books and articles. Over the years, parents' and students' responses to the programme have been extremely positive. To cope with the increasing demand from the expansion of classes, the School now offers two classes of Alternative Chinese Programme in each grade.

Throughout the year, a wide range of activities, talks and visits were designed. G4 students attended a workshop on the basics of flower stands, a traditional Chinese handicraft. G5 students participated in the *Water Margin* (水滸傳) voice-acting competition, which allowed them to step into the characters' shoes and become more interested in the novel. Students also attended a talk on interesting historical stories about the Southern District. In G6, a speech competition in which students expounded on their creative ideas for new extracurricular activities was organised; and a visit to Haw Par Mansion was arranged to strengthen their understanding of local history.

#### **MATHEMATICS**

The new Mathematics Education KLA curriculum was successfully extended to G5 this year. The main goals of the new curriculum were to develop students' ability to conceptualize, inquire, reason, communicate, formulate and solve problems mathematically. There was also an emphasis on integrating STEM education, promoting IT through e-learning and developing reading skills for better comprehension of real-life mathematical complications.

The transition to the new curriculum in G1-5 this year was smooth. Students have moved to a new era to pursue knowledge, skills and attitudes. The new curriculum will be implemented in G6 next year, and the adoption of the new curriculum from G1 to G6 will be accomplished by the end of 2022-2023.

Two school-based workbooks on Number Sense were written for each grade to help students develop essential number sense and calculation skills as part of the 2021-2022 training program.

A school-published exercise book was used in each grade (1st edition in G3-6) to foster students' working habits and learning intelligences.

- G1: the exercise books were published in colour to help students distinguish different objects more easily and effectively, which helped to improve their concentration.
- G2-5: the practice was finished on a weekly basis, one exercise per week. The workload was fair. In fact, many students requested more exercises simply for enjoyment.
- G5: the exercises were tremendously helpful for students to learn algebra later in the year. Their skills in solving equations were stronger than students of previous years.
- G6: half of the topics were related to those they learned throughout the year. It offered the practice to students that the standard syllabus did not cover. Also, students had the opportunity to apply all the number sense and calculation skills they acquired across different G6 topics. They felt content whether or not they could get the correct answers in the end.

By the end of the academic year, some questions were fine-tuned to adjust to the level of difficulty that better suited the students' abilities and interests. Rearrangement of some topics, more intensive practices and new topics will be included in the next editions as part of the new curriculum in the coming year.

Based on students' responses and performance, we know we are heading in the right direction to help our students. We will focus more on helping our students develop logic and reasoning sense. After all, mathematics is not merely about calculations.

# SCIENCE, HEALTH EDUCATION AND STEM

The Science and Health Education (SHE) curriculum aims to help students develop a scientific mindset to assess the world around them analytically. An interdisciplinary approach was adopted to arouse their interest in studying and enjoying all aspects of the programme. Students were given the chance to learn about and apply scientific concepts and methods. Hands-on, minds-on and hearts-on activities were planned to develop students' scientific thinking skills. Additionally, talks and visits were organised to increase students' awareness of the contributions made by science and scientists worldwide. Furthermore, mental health awareness and the digital quotient were finely integrated into the curriculum of all grades to help students solve real-life problems and make healthy, informed decisions.

Due to the pandemic, many visits and sharing sessions were cancelled. However, the SHE teachers ensured that students still had an enriching learning experience. Many activities, sharing sessions and experiments were conducted virtually. Activities

undertaken are summarised below:

- G1: Anatomy Poster Challenge, Green Walk, Healthy Food Plate Project, Weather Observation Month
- G2: Grass Heads in a Cup, Useful Vs Harmful Plants Poster Challenge, Pinwheel Challenge, Snow Globe, St Stephen's Beach Visit, Rock Formation Activity
- G3: My Planetarium, Metamorphosis Activity, Scavenger Hunt, Chlorophyll Paintings, Constructing Digestive System
- G4: Slime Series, St Stephen's Beach Clean-up, Sharing by the Hong Kong Institute of Engineers
- G5: Energy Conversions in Cars, Recycled Houses, Mental Health Awareness Brochures, Cyberbullying Poster Competition
- G6: Battery-operated Fans, Stress Management and Mindfulness

During the special vacation, a Science Trivia Quiz was organised for G1-3 students to keep them in touch with their learning and schoolmates. Approximately 140 students took part in it. A Science competition on Kahoot! was also organised for G4-6. About 80 students participated in testing their scientific knowledge.

Several activities introduced to supplement and enrich students' learning of various aspects of Science and Health Education have become annual events, such as the 5<sup>st</sup> Annual Joyful Fruit Month, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual CNY STEM Challenge, and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Mindful Colouring Marathon.

#### **MUSIC**

The Instrument Programme commenced in September 2021, with face-to-face lessons on campus for strings, percussion and piano; and real-time online lessons for all wind instruments. On 10 May 2022, face-to-face woodwind and brass instrument classes resumed. In response to this, a new schedule and system were developed. An instrument performance examination rubric was developed and introduced to assess students' performances at the instrument exam. Instrument classes on offer are summarised below:

The Music Department collaborated with the Visual Arts (VA) Department to develop a video recording with illustrations as a cross-curricular project. In this project, G2 students learned to sing a traditional English folk song and focused on the cultural aspects of the song in music lessons; in VA lessons, they presented their understanding of the folk song by drawing illustrations according to the lyrics. G2 Music teachers recorded the students' singing, edited the sound files and produced a video with the illustrations.

Rehearsals for the three School Choirs and the School Orchestra commenced in October 2022 after having been suspended for almost one and a half years. In November, twenty piano students were selected, accompanied by their parents, to participate in a Piano Master Class Concert hosted by Ms Eleanor Wong, a renowned Hong Kong pianist. At the College Speech Day and Prize-Giving Ceremony on 12 November 2021, the String Orchestra presented "Entrance of the Queen Sheba" by Handel. On 11 December 2021, the String Orchestra performed in complete darkness as part of one of the activities of the Ethics Education Programme, "Exploration in the Dark".

In January 2021, a Music Marathon was conducted for G2-5 students as part of the Inter-House activities. Students from G2-G5 submitted video recordings to compete for gold, silver and bronze medals. From May to June 2022, the Music Department joined the G6 boarders to participate in "Beats in the City", a community service programme for the elderly in elderly homes. Teachers took lessons with the boarders conducted by outside tutors to perform 'acupuncture tapping' on different parts of the body. After the lessons, a few interactive sessions were facilitated for the boarders to teach the elderly acupuncture tapping, and they collaborated in group sessions.

Our School Orchestra presented two repertoires at the Naming Ceremony of the Agnes Wai Hall on 23 July 2022. The School's Council members, parents, alumni, teachers and students attended this memorable ceremony. A Music Presentation was hosted for the three School Choirs, together with the Alumni Choir and the Parents' Choir, to give a music presentation on 30 July 2022. The Alumni Choir and the Parents' Choir paid tribute to Dr Wai on the occasion of her retirement, and it was the first concert held in the Agnes Wai Hall.

The Education Bureau invited the School to participate in the production of the Music Video 《少年中國說》in celebration of the 73<sup>rd</sup> Anniversary of the Founding of the People's Republic of China in August 2022. The music video aimed to present Chinese arts and culture in the video and cultivate a sense of national identity among the students. The School selected twenty elite members of the Senior Choir to participate in the event.

#### **SPORTS**

The pandemic presented unprecedented challenges for physical education and sports development this academic year. However, the pandemic did not stop dedicated teachers from organising meaningful and educational activities for students to promote physical and mental fitness, especially during these difficult times.

Two new sports, Pickle Ball and Kin-Ball, which proved very popular among our students, were added to our G4-6 and G5-6 curriculum, respectively. A fencing team was formed as fencing has become more popular in the School.

In September, a volleyball workshop for G6 boarders was conducted by Miss Lam Yee Ting, a former Hong Kong Women's Volleyball Team member. A talk for G4-6 students was given by our alumnus, Miss Jamie Yeung, a Hong Kong Olympic athlete and the record holder of the women's 50m Breaststroke and 4x100m Medley Relay, to share her incredible journey as a sportsperson.

A three-day camp was organised in November for G4 and G5 students to experience a variety of fun and educational activities, including discipline training, self-management skills training and cooperative games, in place of the annual overnight education camp.

To cheer our students up and to give them a chance to see their schoolmates during the Special Vacation in March and April, we allied with other departments to organise some interesting virtual learning activities. The PE Department organised activities like "Sweat it Out!", "Teachers vs Students Fitness Competition", and an Inter-House Chopsticks Competition for G1-3 students. We also invited Mr Yapp Hung Fai, a member of the Eastern Sports Club (Hong Kong Premier League) and goalkeeper of the Hong Kong Football Team, to give a virtual talk to our football team. Ms Wan Kin Yee, the current Hong Kong record holder of the 100m, 200m, 400m, 400m hurdles and 4x100m relay, who was also our school athletics team coach and an SSCPS parent, was invited to give a virtual talk to our senior students about her athletic career and how she coped with failure and challenges. Sixty students joined this virtual sharing session.

To encourage students to stay active at home during the period of class suspension, the P.E. Department organised a weekly Virtual ECA called "FitKids Channel". In this ECA, PE teachers did some simple exercises on Zoom and played games about sports on *Kahoot!* Seventy junior-grade students and twenty senior-grade students joined the ECA.

Both the annual Sports Day, originally scheduled for 10 December 2021, and the Swimming Gala, originally scheduled for 11-12 May 2022, were cancelled due to the pandemic. Nevertheless, Special Sports Days for each grade were held on the school campus during the first two weeks of December to make up for the cancelled events. Events at the Special Sports Day included sprinting, high jump, throwing, obstacle races, and the parent-student-teacher Inter-House obstacle race. The Parent-Teacher Association helped recruit over 200 parent volunteers to be the officials at this event.

In July, we invited Mr Kenneth Chung Yee Fung, a former Hong Kong Rope Skipping representative and our rope skipping team coach, as a guest teacher for our G1-6 PE lessons. He taught different rope-skipping tricks and shared his experience with our students. The Games Days were organised in July in lieu of the annual picnic, which was cancelled, and the PTA recruited over a hundred G1-3 parents to set up 12 game booths at the school football field.

Despite the cancellation of many inter-school sports competitions, tryouts where team coaches conducted fitness and skills assessments were conducted to recruit new members for competitions to be held the following year. Students who passed the tryouts were officially selected to be our school team members, and they were all immediately invited to join our teams' summer training sessions.

#### **VISUAL ARTS**

Amidst the interruptions by the pandemic on our learning routine, students continued to be creative. A series of online and face-to-face activities were organised to keep our students' right brain active.

Twenty-two students from G6 joined the Inter-House News Board Design Competition to gain points for their House in January 2022. Students from the four Houses were given art materials and a few weeks to design their House news boards located in Block D. Although the school hours had been reduced due to the pandemic, students managed to work out their designs in their free time and recess time. The competition was keen. The judges, Dr Wai, Mr Wong and Mr Lo, selected the best design based on three criteria: "House Spirit", "Aesthetics", and "Display Clarity". Dragon House won the competition in the end.

To spice up online learning in March 2022, teachers crafted two boot camp activities on Zoom for the senior and junior grades, respectively, with the aim to exercise students' right brains. The objective of the activities was to convince students that creativity is not something inborn but learned, which aligned with the "Growth Mindset" concept in our Ethics Education Programme.

At the start of the boot camp, students were asked to evaluate their level of creativity. A lot of students, especially from the senior grades, reflected that they were unsure whether they were creative or not. Through a series of games and activities, students were guided to learn what creativity was and how to use creative thinking tools to develop original ideas. Creative thinking tools like "start something, anything", "switching perspectives", "designing with constraints", and "embracing lucky accidents" were incorporated into the activities and games during the boot camp so as to let students experiment with the creative process step-by-step. At the end of the camp, senior-grade students were asked to design creative spaces like an architect would, while the junior graders were asked to design monsters with superpowers. Students really enjoyed the boot camp, and their artworks were shared online so that other students could see their work during and after the boot camps.

In April, G5-6 students were invited to join a book cover design competition for the souvenir books produced by the PTA to celebrate Dr Wai's retirement. Those who joined worked on their design during the Easter and Special holidays. After careful selection by the judges from the PTA and our teachers, Stephie King, Sophie King and Ashton Shiu's works were selected. We hope the books will bring our greatest blessings to Dr Wai as she steps into her retired life.

Collaborative art has always been a key feature of our school's art learning. During the post-exam activity week in July 2022, G5 and G6 students worked together to create a large-scale artwork to be displayed on the school campus. Each student was given a triangular piece of a wooden panel. On it, they painted and drew in a designated colour scheme. Putting the wooden panels together like mosaics, they will become a gigantic rainbow on the school campus. The installation will be done in the next academic year as a collaborative art activity that aligns with the school theme under the Ethics Education Programme.

In 2021-2022, students and parents were invited to paint on rocks for the "One-Rock-One-Heart" activity. With the outbreak of the pandemic and school suspensions one after another, the installation was put on hold. Our art teachers glazed the painted rocks one by one to protect the paintings from weathering, and our school artisan, Mr Wong Chi Man, made a video on how to mix the cement glue and glue the rocks around our school campus with our G6 students. The rocks will become a permanent art display on campus that grow with our school and our students. The installation work will be completed by the end of 2022-2023.

#### INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

Coding in design games increases students' interest in programming. In G4 Computer lessons, students made their own games with *Scratch* to learn basic skills in programming. They shared their learning outcomes with classmates and applied their existing knowledge in new ways of thinking about *Scratch*.

A 4G USB Dongle was used to improve data bandwidth for online teaching via Zoom in Block D classrooms to support teaching and learning. Teachers shared videos and other teaching materials with students without losing data. As a result, the quality of teaching was improved.

## Cross-curricular Activities (Computer Studies with Mathematics)

- G1: Based on their Mathematics 2D shapes concepts, students created mathematical drawings using M.S. Paint. They made constructions, pictures and patterns using 2D shapes.
- G4: Students collected weather or temperature data for a week from different cities and created a bar chart using M.S. Excel.
- G5: Students designed a beautiful pattern with circles using *PhotoImpact*. Their drawings consisted of at least ten circles or arcs with contrasting colour pairs.

#### **RELIGIOUS STUDIES**

To let our students experience the power of prayers, the school conducted Prayer Weeks from Weeks 42 to 45. Students were invited to be School Prayer Angels. Their mission as Prayer Angels was to pray to the Lord every night for school, society and the world and to participate in the school morning prayer meetings. Around 45 students signed up to join the activity.

#### **LIBRARY**

The reading theme of 2021-2022 was "HOPE". On display under this theme was a special selection of books chosen by our Chinese and English teachers. The first extension activity was *Book Sharing* for G1-2, and the second extension activity was *My Book Report* for G3-6. Other reading activities included: Mid-Autumn Festival Lantern Riddles (G1-6), Hong Kong Central Library Virtual Tour (G2), the Christmas Book Day display in December, Friday Chinese Storytelling (during Zoom lessons), and IBL theme-related book displays in July.

Parents play an important and valuable role at the SSCPS Library. In 2021-2022, we had fifteen active and long-service parent volunteers. To celebrate our students' love for books and to enrich the school library collection, parents have been invited by our Birthday Book Club to celebrate their child's birthday by donating a book or money to the school library. Each donation is recognised by placing a bookplate with the child's name on the front endpaper of the new book.

#### PREFECT TRAINING

The prefect training was successfully held on 25 September (G5) and 29 October (G6). In the three-hour training sessions held by our elite leaders, students learned how to be responsible prefects by taking part in various games and discussions. Through case studies, they learned how to handle misbehaviours; they were also taught how to serve others with empathy and patience.

The Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups (HKFYG) Heng Fa Chuen Youth SPOT invited our students to participate in the Joint School Leadership Training Programme. Students' leadership and communication skills were enhanced through a series of challenging leadership training activities, including outdoor adventures and talks with CEOs. They were encouraged to have breakthroughs, work as a team, and persevere when facing adversity. The participating schools were St Stephen's College Preparatory School, St Paul's College Primary School, HKUGA Primary School and Buddhist Chung Wah Primary School. Each school nominated twelve prefects to participate in this training.

#### BOARDING PROGRAMME

The G6 Boarding Programme is mainly divided into four areas of training: life-skill training, personal management, community service and cultural activities.

Life-skills training on the following topics was organised for G6 boarders: Self-management, Sewing, First Aid, Shoe Polishing, Cookery, Woodworking and Book Wrapping. For cultural and social skills: Photography, Fitness Dancing, Yoga and Western Dining Etiquette.

The Personal Management Programme consisted of six lessons, each lasting one and a half hours, and was organised to help students set personal goals and develop effective communication skills and self-esteem. The G6 boarders were required to complete challenging tasks like walking in the dark, Roman catapult building and abseiling.

Social and cultural activities were also conducted, and they were: the Mid-Autumn Festival Gathering, Camping Basics, the Country Parks Education Workshop by the Environmental Association and the Savvy Planner Workshop by the Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups.

The English Language Programme included the following topics: language-skills application, poetry creation, recitations and reviews, drama, story writing, gratefulness cards, vocabulary learning, writing practice and speaking practice.

In Beats in the City 「耆」妙節拍, students shared their music and communicated with the elderly at the AKA Social Service Linkages Lam Ki Yip Centre. Students learned to empathise and share their happiness with the elderly; they also experienced harmonious inclusion.

Our school is now recognised as a "Heart to Heart School" because our students have participated in over 500 accumulated hours of voluntary services.

#### CROSS-CURRICULAR COLLABORATIONS

Cross-curricular teaching and learning have always been an essential part of our curriculum. This year we tried a bottom-up collaborative approach to enhance collaborations among teachers. More than a dozen collaborative projects were created thanks to the concerted effort of teachers from all the subjects.

The English, Chinese and Visual Arts Departments collaborated to design lessons in which G4 students created clay farmhouse models based on their English reader, *The Butterfly Lion*; G5 students made sand paintings based on the Chinese articles Spring and *The Blossoming of Sunflowers*; they also made spinning illusions to illustrate the story of *Fish in a Tree*. Student artworks were exhibited in the library and outside the classrooms in June and July.

In the Mini-battle of the Books, G2 and G3 students read books about sports and art to

join the "battle". G3 students played bowling in P.E. lessons and used their experience to write a descriptive essay on actions in Chinese.

The Mathematics Department collaborated with the P.E., Computer and VA Departments to design projects for students to experience distance and time (G3); speed (G6); 2D & 3D shapes (G1), directions (G2), block graphs (G3), bar charts (G4), patterns (G5) in Computer and VA lessons by creating graphic art based on these concepts.

The cross-curricular collaborations have proven beneficial for both students and teachers, as students learned transferable problem-solving skills while cross-curricular planning fostered collegiality among teachers.

#### INTER-HOUSE ACTIVITIES

The Annual House Cup is organised to enhance students' sense of belonging to their House and the school. The following activities were conducted for the Annual House Cup.

English Inter-House Competitions: In the *Poster Design Competition for Roald Dahl Day*, G3-4 students designed a new chocolate bar for Willy Worka's factory; in the *Personal Growth Programme Record Book Cover Design Competition*, G1-6 students designed the cover for their PGP record books; in the *Battle of the Books*, G3 students competed to answer questions on the books they read about the lives of athletes and artists.

Chinese Inter-House Competitions: To enhance students' confidence in speaking Putonghua, the Chinese teachers organised a *Tongue Twister Competition* for GI students. To enhance students' interest in writing, *Chinese Writing Competitions* were held. In G2, students wrote a passage on their One Person One Flower experience of growing plants; in G3, students wrote a passage about their experience during a *Bowling Competition*. A *Putonghua Dubbing Competition* was organised for G5 students to voice over characters in a video, and a *Drama Competition* was organised for G6 students to prepare a skit based on the classic Chinese story "The Journey to the West" (西遊記).

Mathematics Inter-House Competitions: Several inter-house competitions to test students' skills and knowledge in Mathematics were organised. G1-2 competed on speed calculations, G3 students solved addition, subtraction and multiplication problems in a *Smart Detective competition*, and G5 students participated in a competition on prime numbers.

Physical Education Competitions: House points were awarded to winners of all sports events at the Sports Day, including the *Inter-House Obstacle Race*. In addition, a *Shoe Lacing Competition* was organised for G1-2 students, a Bowling Competition for G3, a *Badminton Competition* with live broadcasts for G1-6 students, and a virtual *Plank Get-up Competition* for all parents and students to stay active at home during the class suspension period.

Other inter-house competitions included the *Animation Design Competition* for G1-2 students, organised by the Computer Studies Department; the *House Board Design Competition* for G6, organised by the Visual Arts Department; and the *Music Marathon*, organised by the Music Department.

Dragon House won the House of the Year in 2021-2022 with the highest accumulated score. To celebrate, a Dragon Day was organised on 8 July 2022, and all teachers were dressed in green. Dragon House students of each grade enjoyed different activities organised by the teachers. G1 students were taken to St Stephen's Beach to participate in a scavenger hunt; G2 participated in a bowling competition in the School Hall; G3 enjoyed Switch Sports in the STEM Room; G4 students played cooperative games; G5

played dodgeball at the Covered Playground, and G6 enjoyed wall climbing. All the Dragon House students had a lot of fun.

#### ETHICS EDUCATION PROGRAMME (EEP)

The 2021-2022 School Theme was *Come to Learn, Go to Serve*. Several activities were conducted in collaboration with the PMA Music Foundation to convey the importance of inclusion and service to parents and students. Activities included: *Exploration in the Dark*, motivational talks, *Beats in the City, One Day with the Blind, and Sound Map*.

The kick-off activity, *Exploration in the Dark*, was held in collaboration with the PMA Music Foundation and the Hong Kong Society for the Blind. It was a whole-day event that took place in the School Hall in December 2021. 614 students and their family members signed up. 243 tickets were allocated on a first-come-first-served basis. In this activity, participants were guided by the visually impaired group leaders to navigate the Hall in complete darkness. They were then challenged to perform simple everyday activities like packing their school bags, arranging objects in the correct order, and "watching" a movie with audio descriptions. In the end, our orchestra members collaborated to perform a piece of music with the visually impaired violinist Ding Yijie.

Two motivational sharing sessions on the importance of inclusion and empathy were conducted on 9 April (online) and 21 May (face-to-face), respectively, by Mr Chong Chan-yan, Mr Yang Enhua and Miss Michelle Siu, who are visually impaired. The father of Ms Siu also shared the pains and joys of raising a visually impaired child. 67 and 38 families joined the sharing sessions, respectively. Students and parents were impressed and inspired by their speeches.

In the activity *Beats in the City*, G6 boarders visited the AKA Social Service Linkages Lam Ki Yip Centre and performed beating the basic acupoints with a short piece of music. Through communicating and collaborating with the elderly, students learned to empathise and share their happiness. Most importantly, they experienced harmonious inclusion.

In the *Sound Map* activity, G3 students were encouraged to explore nature and appreciate life by walking around, tuning in, and drawing sound maps of the school campus.

The final project of the EEP programme, *One Day with the Blind*, which was launched in July, allowed students and their families to visit Hong Kong attractions under the guidance of the visually impaired. Over 100 families enrolled; however, due to the pandemic, only 26 families eventually participated. Positive feedback was collected through the post-activity questionnaire and sharing session on 22 July.

# NATIONAL SECURITY EDUCATION (NSE)

To supervise the overall planning and coordination of work related to safeguarding national security and national security education (NSE) at the school, the NSE Committee, which consisted of the Principal, Deputy Principals and three Senior Teachers, was formed in February 2021. The Committee's function is to supervise the overall planning and coordination of the work related to safeguarding national security and NSE at the school.

The Committee planned the mechanics of the national flag-raising ceremony. It will be an ongoing weekly ceremony to strengthen students' sense of national identity. The national flag is to be raised on special days, and the National Anthem will be sung before all important school events. Different activities, including reading, writing, games and competitions, were also organised over the year by the subject departments to enhance students' national identity.

#### STUDENT HEALTH AND WELFARE

#### Vaccinations

In October 2021, the Seasonal Influenza Vaccination School Outreach 2021/22 Programme was offered to students by the Department of Health. A total of 544 students participated in the programme. In July 2022, the Covid-19 Vaccination Subsidy Scheme was offered to students by the Department of Health. A total of 274 students participated in the programme. Dedicare Limited sponsored both programmes.

## **Counselling Services**

In 2021-2022, counselling services were offered to 98 families; and student learning support was offered through emotional management training, cognitive behavioural therapy and applied behavioural analysis.

Students and their families had been affected psychologically and emotionally by the pandemic. The issues of time management and maintaining healthy relationships with family members were discussed during the counselling sessions. Follow-up actions were done to check up on students' emotions and behaviours during and after the face-to-face class suspension period.

Regular contact with parents was maintained to keep track of students' learning progress, especially for students with special needs. 67 regular meetings were organised between students, teachers, and parents throughout the year.

#### PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION (PTA)

The Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) serves as a bridge to enhance communication between the School and home. The PTA Newsletter, PTA Facebook, WhatsApp Groups and Recycled Uniform Facebook Group helped to facilitate this communication.

In the midst of the pandemic, a variety of activities were organised by the PTA. They included: G1-6 parent tea gatherings with administrators from the School and College; a community service project, *Cheers for Hong Kong Heroes*; a joint-association activity, as part of the SSC Alliance, to raise funds for the *Big Field Reconstruction Outdoor Track* at the College; the Games Day; and the e-Time Capsule project.

The first e-Time Capsule reunion was held on 6 August 2022. Graduates of the Class of 2012 returned to meet each other, revisit their shared memories and watch videos of their journey at the Prep School. Graduates who were unable to travel to Hong Kong joined the reunion virtually.

The PTA also supported school activities in many ways. To show their support at the Sports Day, the PTA recruited around 43 parent volunteers from each grade to support the event. During the Special Holidays in March and April 2022, the PTA hosted fun activities on *Padlet* and *Zoom* for students and their parents. The activities included reading, storytelling, presentations, magic, AI programming, cooking, SoSo club gatherings, yoga, etc. A total of 1781 visitors joined the platforms.

To celebrate Dr Wai's retirement, the PTA produced two souvenir booklets filled with personalised messages from teachers, parents and students. Together with the retirement gift, a customised music box capturing the School Song *Our Hearts Are Young, Our Ideals High,* and the theme song of e-Time Capsule, *Till We Meet Again,* the booklets and a unique Print of Retirement, were presented to Dr Wai. As part of the celebration, a retirement walk with our G6 graduates and a party with Friends of SSCPS were held on 28 July and 27 August, respectively.

#### MAINTENANCE AND INSTALLATIONS

Essential maintenance and repair work was carried out for the upkeep and safety of the campus. The maintenance and repair work in 2021-2022 included:

• Air-conditioning repair and replacement work for Block A (Staff Room, General Office and Meeting Room), Block B (Classrooms and Music Instrument Storage Room), Block C (Dining Hall and Boys' Dormitories), Block D and Block G (Classrooms).

Replacement of the metallic mesh at the soccer field and the metal gates behind the

Dining Hall.

Renovation and repair work for several staff quarters.

• Inspection, testing and certification of the fixed electrical installations in Blocks A, C & D; leakage pressure test for the air-conditioning system in Block B; and an annual inspection of the fire service system in Block G.
